

# Terms and Conditions

## Conditions of Carriage

Irish Ferries Ltd. (hereafter called the carrier) Incorporated in Ireland, Registered Office: Alexandra Road, Dublin 1.

The attention of passengers and goodsowners is drawn to the restriction of their rights and the limitations of the carrier's liability by the carrier's conditions of travel, which also cover periods preceding and following the period of carriage on the vessel.

Carriage of passengers and their accompanied luggage, vehicles and domestic animals kept as pets is subject to the Carrier's Conditions of Travel of Passengers and Passengers Accompanied Property, copies of which are available on application to any of the Carrier's offices. The said Conditions incorporate in respect of any carriage by sea which the Carrier has agreed to undertake the 1974 Athens Convention as amended by Protocol dated at London on 19th November 1976, relating to the Carriage of Passengers and their Luggage by Sea, which in most cases limits the Carrier's liability for death of or personal injury to a passenger and/or for loss of or damage to luggage (including a vehicle) and makes special provision for valuables. The Athens Convention presumes that luggage has been delivered undamaged unless written notice is given to the carrier

(i) in the case of apparent damage, before or at the time of disembarkation or redelivery or from the time which such redelivery should have taken place.

It shall be a condition of the contract of travel entered into between the Carrier and the Passenger, that the Passenger has the required immigration documentation necessary for entry into the country of destination. Prior to boarding, the Carrier (or his agent) shall be entitled to check that all passengers have in their possession valid documentation to comply with the immigration laws of the country of destination. The Carrier may (notwithstanding any booking previously made) refuse to carry any passenger who fails to produce satisfactory documentation when requested. In such circumstances, the Carrier shall be entitled to deduct a cancellation fee prior to refunding to the passenger any fares paid. The passenger shall not be entitled to any other compensation from the Carrier where permission to travel has been refused. The Carrier shall be entitled to re-claim from the passenger all fines or other costs levied on it by reason of the passenger's failure to produce immigration documentation satisfactory to the relevant authorities upon reaching the port of destination. In addition any passenger who for any reason refuses to disembark or is refused entry to the relevant country at the port of destination shall be required to reimburse the Carrier for any costs incurred by the Carrier as a result of such action.

All goods other than those specified in paragraph (1) are accepted and carried on the Carrier's Standard Conditions of Carriage of Goods (copies available on application to any of the Carrier's offices), some terms of which limit the Carrier's liability and/or affect the rights of goodsowners. Consignors of all such goods must apply for and obtain a consignment note prior to shipment.

In so far as any booking relates or gives rise to carriage otherwise than on any vessel or other means of transport owned or operated by the Carrier (whether or not the cost thereof has been included in any fare or other sums paid to the Carrier), the Carrier undertakes only to arrange the same as agent for and on behalf of the passenger or goodsowner with the party or parties providing such carriage on any terms and conditions currently used by such party or parties.

Every person making a booking for or on behalf of a passenger or group of passenger or for or on behalf of a goodsowner warrants and confirms that the authority of each such passenger or goodsowner to accept the Carrier's Conditions of Travel as agent for and on behalf of that passenger or goodsowner and that each passenger or goods owner agrees to be bound by the Carrier's Condition of Travel.

The Carrier or Master may (notwithstanding any booking made) refuse to carry any passenger or luggage on any sailing for any cause relating to the safety of the vessel or any property on board the vessel or to the safety, comfort or convenience of any other passenger or any servant, agent or independent contractor of the Carrier directly or indirectly involved with the carriage in question. In such circumstances that passenger shall not be entitled to any compensation or payment whatsoever save that the Carrier shall refund to the passenger any fare or other charges paid to the Carrier in respect of that sailing.

The following items are classified as dangerous and may not be transported for reasons of safety and security.

- Explosive materials such as munitions, fireworks, toy gun caps and flares
- Gases (flammable or toxic) such as camping gas, compressed gas cylinders.
- Tear gas, mace or CS gas devices.
- Flammable materials such as petrol, lighter fuel, paints and thinner non safety matches and fire lighters.
- Oxidizing material
- Poisonous materials such as weed killers and insecticides.
- Radioactive materials/irritants such as mercury, acids, alkali and battery acid
- Magnetic materials.

For reasons of security no sharp objects may be transported as hand luggage. Irish Ferries accepts no responsibility for items removed from your luggage. Specific requirements exist for the carriage of firearms. Please contact us for more details.

Vehicles with luggage loaded on the roof in excess of six feet (1.90 metres) from ground level or protruding beyond the length of the vehicle are subject to availability of space carried only by special agreement with the Carrier and at such additional charges as may from time to time be determined by the Carrier.

Passengers accompanied by a vehicle must check in at the point of embarkation not less than one hour prior to the advertised sailing time. Bookings for person under 16, unaccompanied by an adult, will not be accepted.

Motorist fares exclude certain Vehicles which may be subject to Freight Rates. Check our website FAQs page 'Travelling in a Van' for details.

All sailings and schedules are subject to cancellation or variation without notice.

Passengers and goods owners are advised to arrange insurance in respect of their luggage and other property (including vehicles). Insurance may be effected through the Carrier. Details available on application to any office of the Carrier or its agents.

Special Reduced Fares or Excursion Rates should be requested before making any portion of a journey or journeys to which they apply. Claims for retrospective benefits under these schemes cannot be entertained by the company. All Special Offers are subject to space availability/special conditions and may be withdrawn or altered without prior notice and apply to the current year only, unless previously stated.
